REVIEW OF CLARK COUNTY BUILDING DEPARTMENT – INSPECTION SERVICES INITIAL AUDIT RESPONSE LETTER

A review was conducted on your initial audit review response letter that was in response to the Clark County Department of Building (CCDB) initial audit letter dated May 30, 2014. The CCDB initial audit letter addressed a total of twelve (12) items that were noted by the auditor.

In your response letter, you addressed each of the items noted in the CCDB letter and any corrective actions that were taken to correct the audit findings. Your audit review response letter has been accepted base on your response to the noted items.

The Clark County approved fabricator program is currently accepted by several other jurisdictions in the state of Nevada and surrounding states. It is important that the fabricator understand that all fabrication is required to comply with the fabricators Clark County approved Quality Systems Manual, when the projects building authority having jurisdiction, approves the fabricator based on the fabricator's current CCDB approval. The fabricator is responsible for assuring that all fabrication complies with all Clark County approved fabricator requirements, approved project plans and specifications, and any additional requirements imposed by the projects jurisdictional building authority.

Your CCDB approved metal building fabricator status will be renewed based on your May 30, 2014 audit results and your response letter. An approved fabricator confirmation letter is enclosed.
